The Clarkston Historic District Commission approved a <u>Certificate of Appropriateness</u> at their January 9, 2018 meeting. The proposed work was for:

Addition of a "mudroom" vestibule on the south side at the existing side entrance. While proposed to match the existing, permission could vary from the existing trim, columns and details to differentiate the new construction from the existing. Repair/rehabilitate the existing front porch to match existing details.

A Certificate of Appropriateness (CoA) is only approval for the requirements of the City of the Village of Clarkston Historic District and does not replace or supersede zoning, building construction permit, other city ordinance and legal requirements.
