During an October 12, 2021 meeting, the Clarkston Historic District Commission (HDC) approved a Certificate of Appropriateness (CoA) for repairs to be performed on a wrought iron fence with brick columns 21 East Washington, based on the application dated October 4, 2021.

Application is for repair of wrought iron fence and brick columns that were damaged by a vehicle. Application is supported by photos of the damage. The damage will be repaired using existing materials and appropriate matching mortar. No applicable Standards are cited since this is repair only.

A Certificate of Appropriateness (CoA) is only approval for the requirements of the City of the Village of Clarkston Historic District and does not replace or supersede zoning, building construction permits, other city ordinances and legal requirements.
