This Commission is pleased to grant a <u>Certificate of Appropriateness</u> for proposed work at 62 Buffalo Street.

The Commission approves the following:

Installing new vinyl windows, as presented;

• Replacing side porch pillars as presented, but without the midway detail to keep it simpler, and more in keeping with a 1970s style;

Re-roofing and re-shingling with a simple flat profile, if necessary;

Wrapping the soffits in aluminum;

Adding aluminum gutters and downspouts;

Repairing or replacing elements of the side porch with like materials.

As proposed, this work meets standard number three of the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation, Each property will be recognized as a physical record of its time, place, and use. Changes that create a false sense of historical development, such as adding conjectural features or elements from other historic properties, will not be undertaken.

As always, if your plans change in detail, material, scope, mass, size, scale, or if you add windows, doors, or anything of the like, kindly please submit a new application for Historic District Commission review and approval.

A Certificate of Appropriateness is not the equivalent of a building permit. Applicants are still required to obtain the necessary permits and approvals from the building inspector, and to follow established guidelines within the City of the Village of Clarkston.
