This Commission is pleased to grant a <u>Certificate of Appropriateness</u> for proposed work at 69 E. Washington Street, as presented. The Commission approves:

- Replacing various wooden window sashes with new wooden window sashes that have the same glazing pattern and that replicate the same measurements to fit inside the exisiting (though possibly repaired or replaced with like-for-like materials) window frames.
- Replacing utility doors with like wooden doors. The two lakefront doors are to be replaired or replaced.

The project, as presented, successfully meets several of the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation, particularly standard numbers two — which states that "historic character of a property shall be retained and preserved. The removal of historic materials or alteration of features and spaces that characterize a property shall be avoided." — and six, which states, "Deteriorated historic features shall be repaired rather than replaced. Where the severity of deterioration requires replacement of a distinctive feature, the new feature shall match the old in design, color, texture, and other visual qualities and, where possible, materials."
