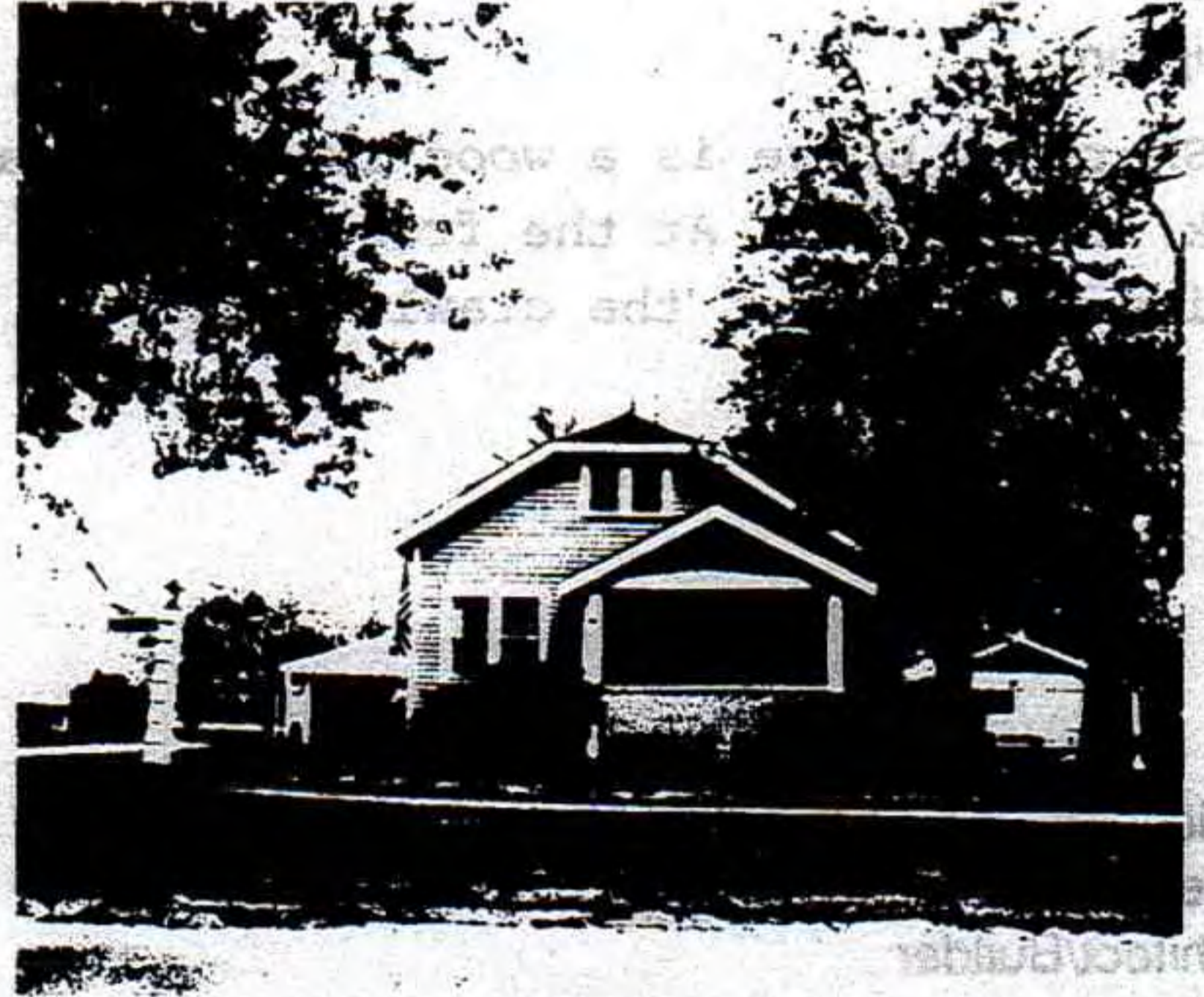

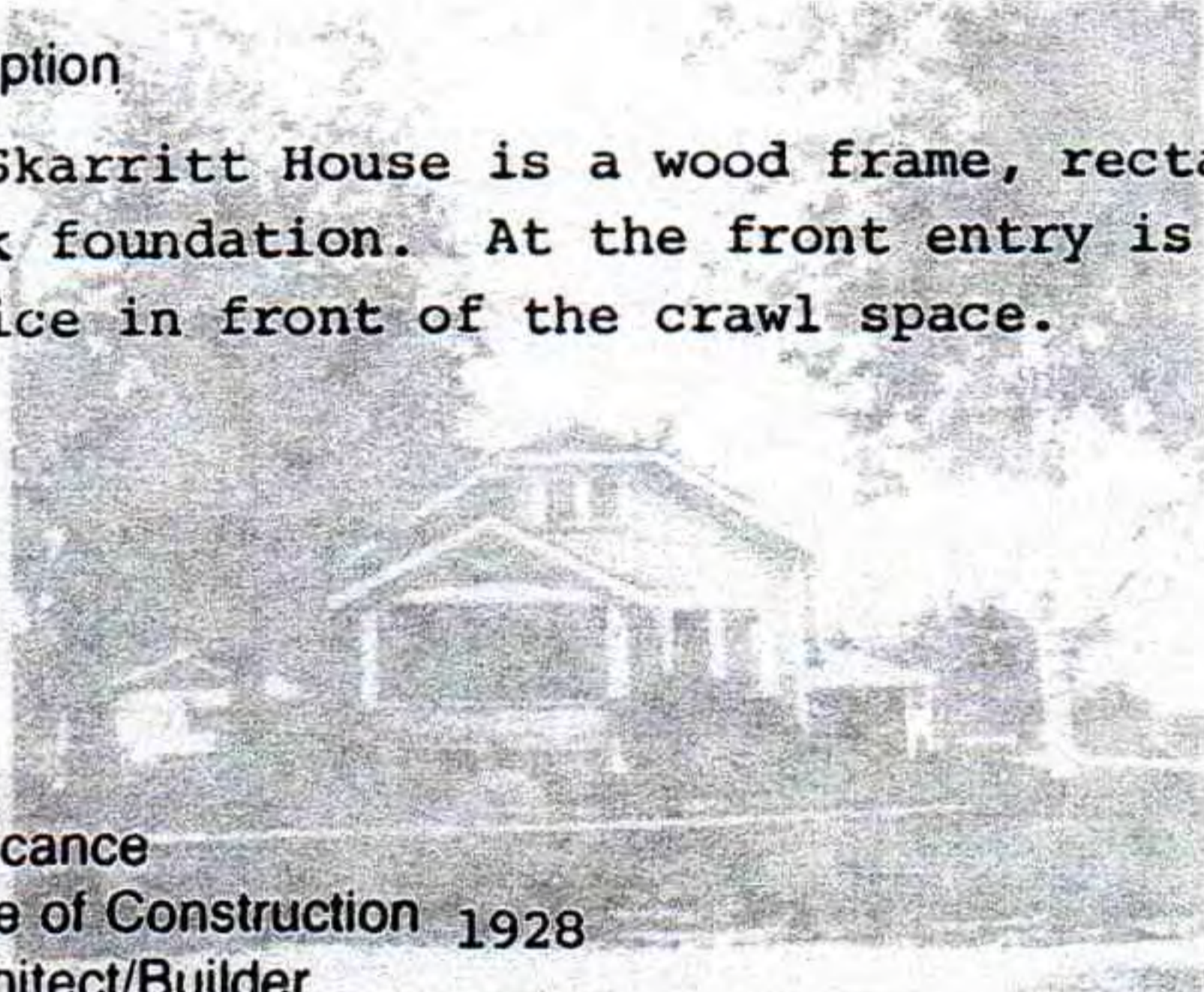

Description

The Skarritt House is a wood frame, rectangular, clapboard building on a concrete block foundation. At the front entry is a screen enclosed porch with wood vertical lattice in front of the crawl space.



Significance

The House is typical of the one and one half story homes built in the late 20's and 30's in Clarkston. Special features include the hipped front gable and the gable pitched roof over the porch.
