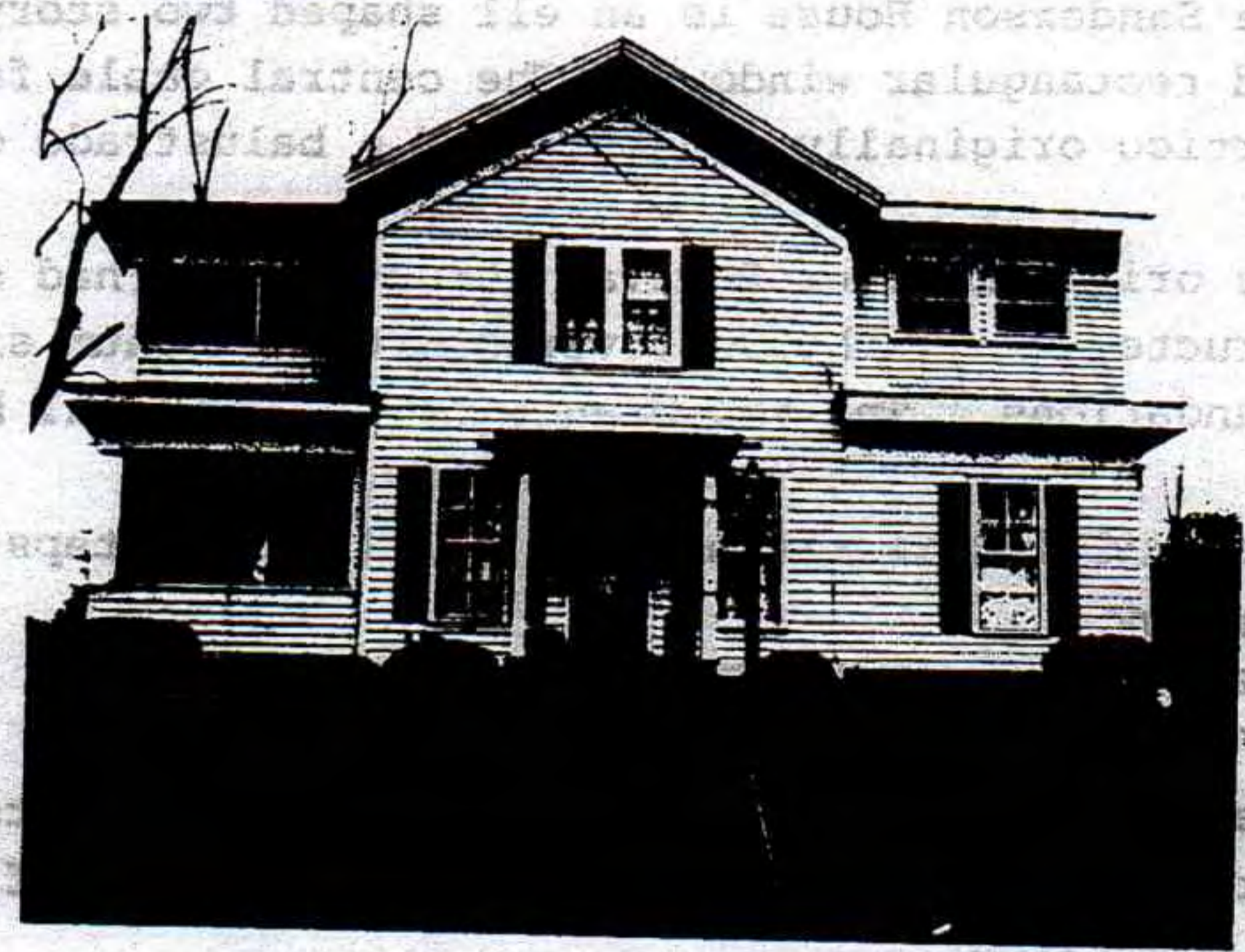

Description

The Sanderson House is an ell shaped two story wood frame structure with clapboard siding and rectangular windows. The central gable faces S. Holcomb St. and the front entry portico originally consisted of a balustrade on the portico roof.

The original Greek Revival structure has had several additions to it. These were constructed of clapboard covered with aluminum siding over a wood frame on concrete block foundations. The appearance of the original building has been altered by these additions.

The building is situated on a hill with steps leading to the front entry from the street.

The Sanderson Residence is significant for its prominent location on Holcomb and Depot Streets and its original construction date of ca 1850 which represents early development in Clarkston.
